Notice of Construction: Trafford Median Islands

The City Commission has approved the construction of traffic calming islands on Trafford Road between Coolidge Highway and Woodward Avenue. These islands were approved by the City Commission on April 12, 2021 after months of public feedback and recommendations presented by the Royal Oak Citizens Traffic Committee.

The contractor awarded this work is Mark Anthony Contracting, Inc. of Milford, Michigan. City engineering staff will administer and inspect the project.

Scope of work: Installation of two traffic calming islands on Trafford Road between Coolidge Highway and the public alley. The purpose of these islands are to promote slower vehicle speeds. Permit parking spots will not be impacted by this construction, but some public on-street parking spots west of the alley will be removed.

Construction timeline: Construction will begin **late June 2021** and extend through **late July 2021**. Work is currently not scheduled for Sundays or holidays.



Advanced notices:

Parking - During construction, there will be lane restrictions on Trafford Road to allow for construction equipment and material stockpiling. "No Parking - Tow Away Zone - 7:00a.m. - 8:00p.m." signs will be posted 12 hours in advance where required to allow for various construction operations.

Road Closures - There will be intermittent closures of Trafford Road to allow for construction. The contractor will plan to accommodate Trafford Road residents throughout construction as much as possible.

Please **DO NOT** move barricades or drive on new concrete until the barricades are removed by the contractor. Property owners who remove barricades and drive on the concrete will be billed for the cost to repair any damaged concrete.

Trash Pickup: Unless otherwise notified, there will be no change in the trash pickup dates and the trash will be taken care of as usual during the construction operations. If necessary, the trash may need to be moved by the contractor to the nearest intersection for pickup. **Please have address markings on all trash and recycling containers so they can be returned to the proper house.**
