## **Additional Incidents and Information**

### **Armed Robbery at Business**

A suspect is being sought by the Royal Oak Police for a reported armed robbery at Martinizing Dry Cleaners early Friday morning. Officers responded to the store located at 1015 S. Main on April 1, 2022, at 7:14 a.m., after receiving a 911 call from an employee. Officers learned a male suspect implied he was armed, demanded money from the employee, and then fled the store.

Royal Oak K-9 officers responded to the scene to assist as officers attempted to locate the suspect. The suspect, described as a black male, 6', 200 lbs., wearing a black hat, black & grey hoodie, tan pants, black face mask, and black boots, was last seen fleeing southbound on Main Street. The employee was uninjured.

### **Possession of Cocaine and Possession of Synthetic Narcotic Arrest**
